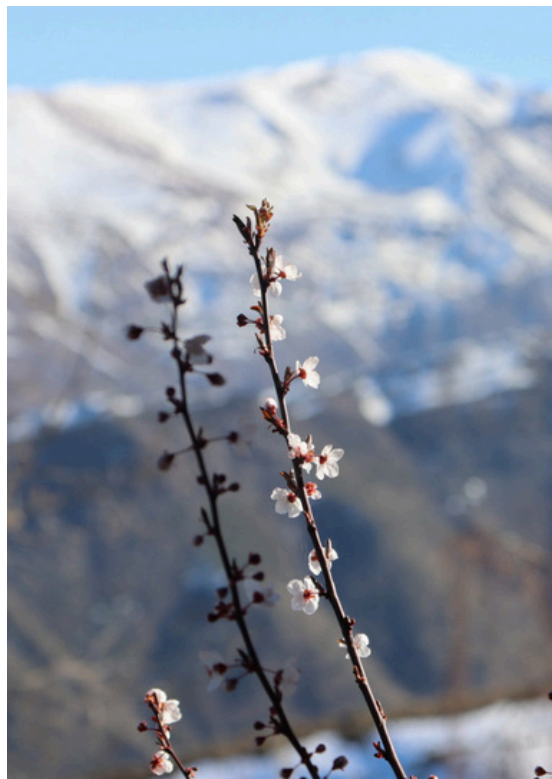


Cold mornings in the mountains.

1 THURSDAY 27 AUG

Arrival Santiago + Fukasawa + Farellones

Arrive in the morning, lunch at Fukasawa, drive up to Farellones, check-in, sunset and welcome.

No skiing today – too tight on time.



2 FRIDAY 28 AUG

Ski Farellones / Valle Nevado

First day on the snow.

A great day to get started.



3 SATURDAY 29 AUG

Ski or Flexible Day

Ski for the motivated, or a more relaxed experience for those who need it. Keep it flexible.



4 SUNDAY 30 AUG

Farellones → Wine Valley → Pichilemu

Pure storytelling: snow, wine and sunset by the ocean.

The ultimate Do Local moment.



5 MONDAY 31 AUG

Pichilemu → Las Trancas

A full day on the road with great music, beautiful stops and good vibes.

Arrive late, cozy dinner.



6 MON 31 AUG – FRI 4 SEP

Las Trancas (4 nights)

Depth, not a quick pass through.

Ski Nevados, hot springs/tinaja, forest, fire, rest and community.



7 FRIDAY 4 SEP

Las Trancas → Corralco

Depart in the morning, scenic stop along the way, arrive at Posada del Río.



8 FRI 4 – MON 7 SEP

Corralco (3 nights)

A weekend in Corralco feels more remote and special. Volcano skiing, nature, and one Open Table night.



9 MONDAY 7 SEP

Corralco → Pucón

Morning option: hike Malachauello or ski (conditions permitting).

Then, drive to Pucón and unwind in the hot springs.



10 TUESDAY 8 SEP

Pucón – Ski Day + Asado Dinner

Full day to ski the volcano (conditions permitting). In the evening, celebrate with a traditional asado dinner.



11 WEDNESDAY 9 SEP

Surprise Activity (AM) + Transfer Temuco

A surprise local experience to close the trip. Transfer to Temuco airport in the afternoon.

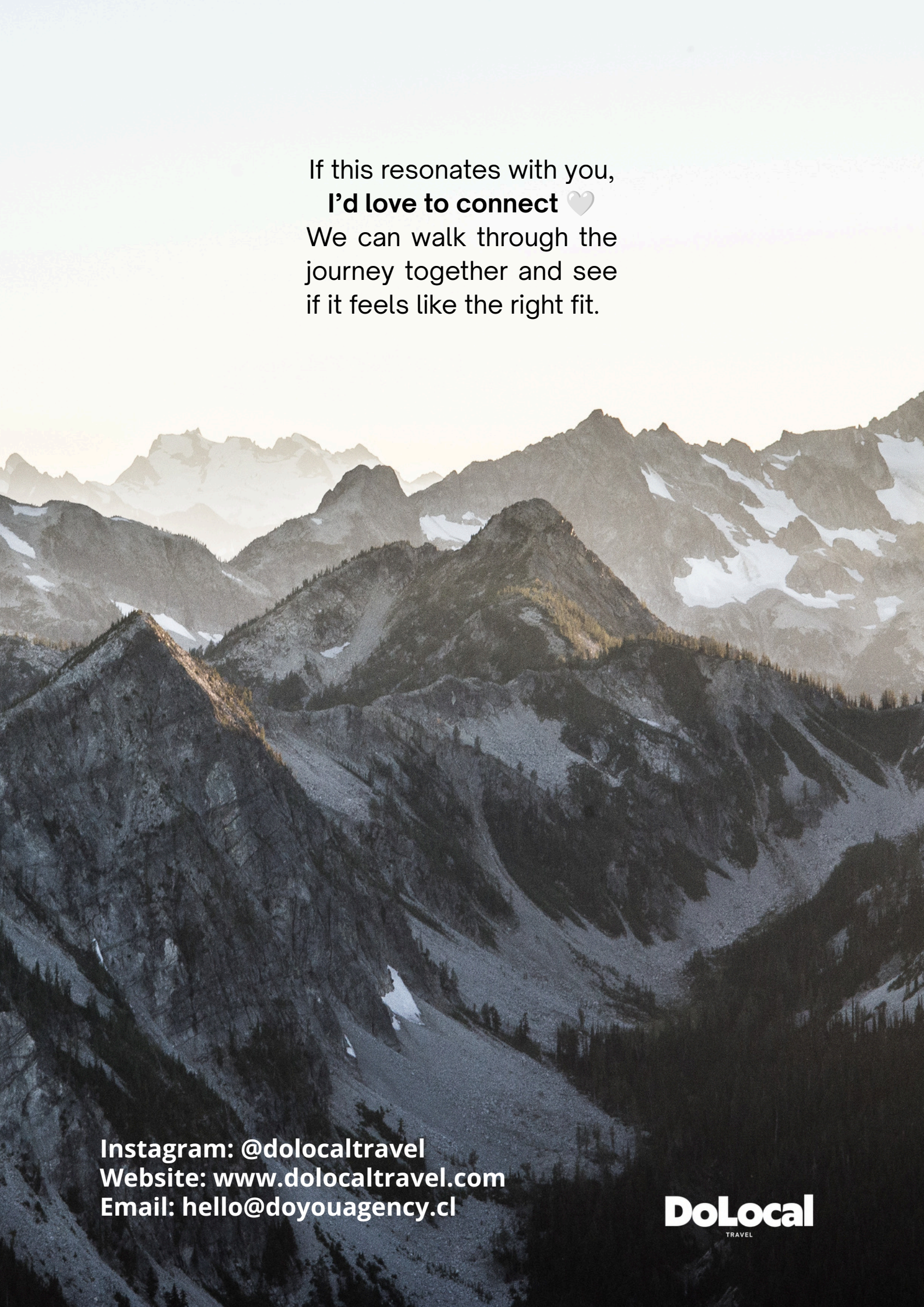
