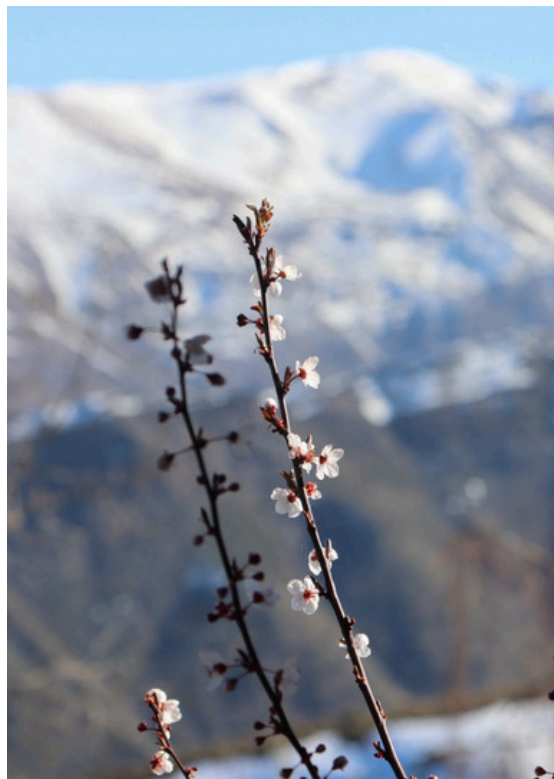


Cold mornings in the mountains.

This is where adventure meets stillness.



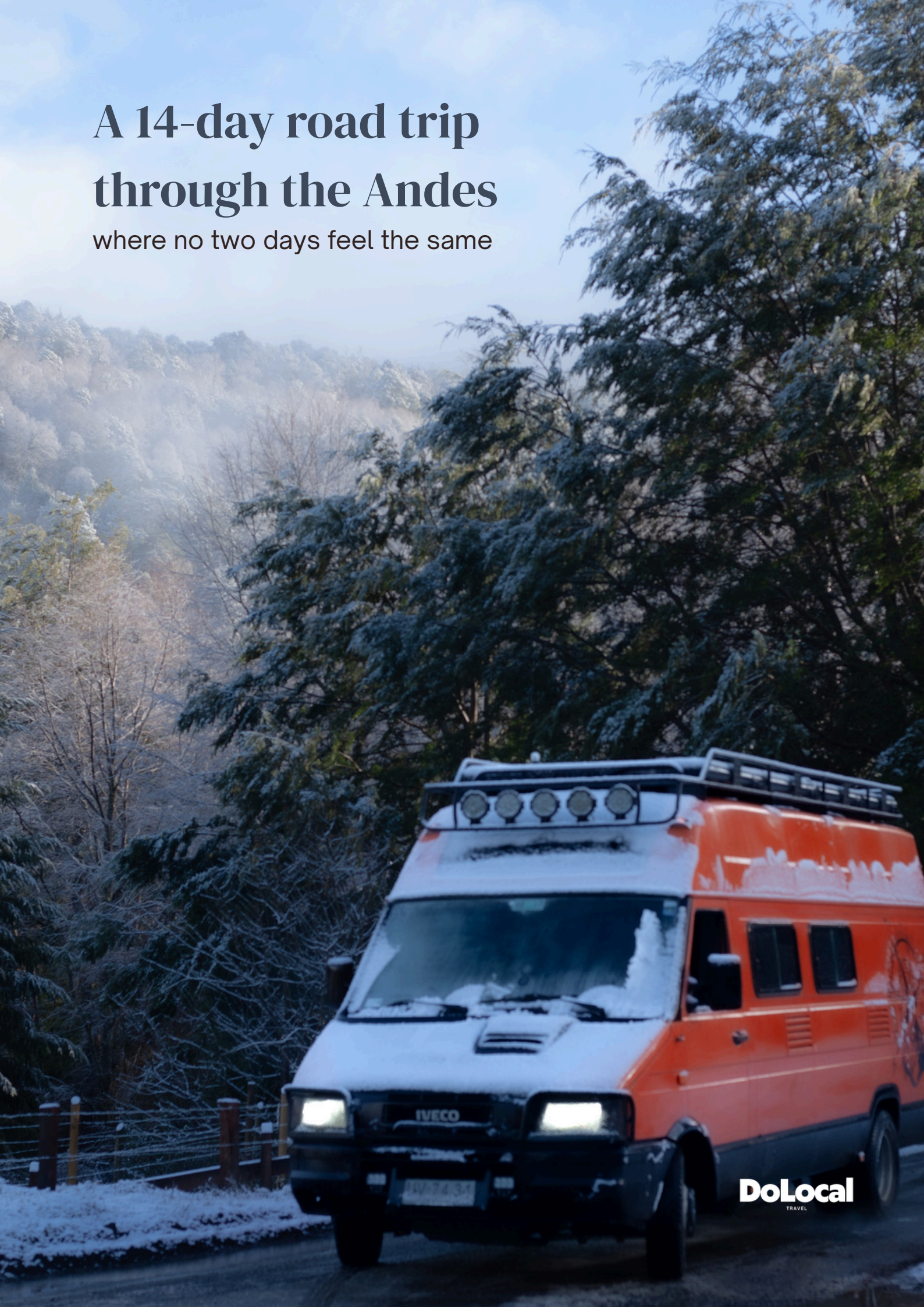

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DAYS 1–3

Arrival + First Tracks in the Andes

Arrive in Santiago, settle into the mountains, and begin with a welcome dinner.

Wake up surrounded by the Andes and ease into your first ski days in Farellones.

DAY 4

A day of Snow, Wine & Sea

Wake in the Andes, surrounded by snow, and begin to feel just how narrow Chile truly is. A long lunch in the winery valleys with a refined Carménère, ending with sunset over the Pacific in Pichilemu.

DAY 5

Pichilemu & Andes Hot Springs

A slower day to take it all in. Morning by the ocean, optional surf, followed by hidden hot springs in the mountains and time to unwind.

DAYS 6–7

Las Trancas - Fire & Forest

Ski volcanic terrain surrounded by ancient forests, with evenings around open-fire BBQs.



DAY 8

Road Through the Andes

A scenic journey south as the landscapes become deeper, wilder, and more remote.

DAYS 9–10

Corralco - Volcanic Skiing

Ski on the slopes of a volcano. Afternoons to slow down, nights under the stars around the fire.

DAY 11

Into the Wild

A day to step off the slopes. Hike and connect with the raw nature of the Araucarian region.

DAYS 12–13

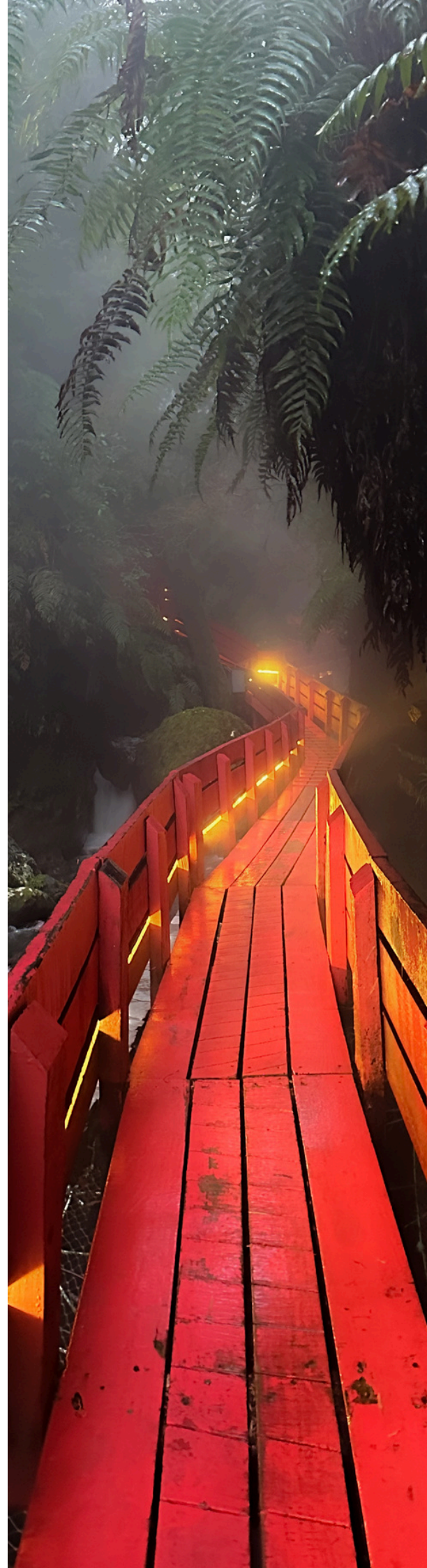
Pucón - Adventure & Hot Springs

Ski with views of the Villarrica volcano, then unwind in natural hot springs and close the journey with one final open-fire dinner.

DAY 14

Departure

Breakfast, a final farewell, and return to Santiago by air.


